To bring owners of America's Sports Car living in the area together in a manner that enhances the Corvette experience for all.

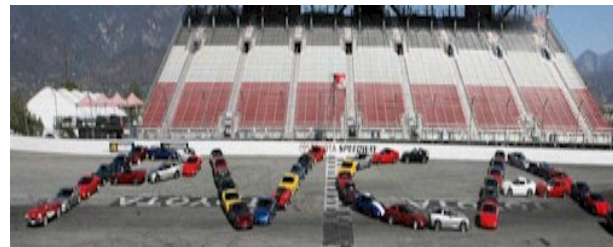

MEMBERSHIP...

- You must be a registered owner of a Chevrolet Corvette or are waiting on delivery of a Corvette
- You must hold a driver's license valid in the United States
- You must meet financial responsibility requirements set forth in the Vehicle Code of your state of residence when operating a motor vehicle in conjunction with, in transit to or in transit from a PVCA function – **means you have to have insurance!**
- In cases of multiple registered owners of a single Corvette, all persons listed as registered owners and members, must meet all requirements in the bylaws
- You must attend three functions (either General Membership meetings or PVCA events) within three months. At the first General Membership meeting after fulfilling the attendance requirement, or any General membership meeting thereafter, the prospective member may request to join and the membership will vote to approve their application for membership
